Stop by Bldg #2 (office) and get registered for this year's FUN RUN!!


Races start at 8:00 am on SATURDAY in front of Bldg #2

Building 1: Dining Hall: Tables for breakfast, lunch, hot and cold drinks, large stationary steam engine.

Building 2: <u>Association Office:</u> Logo apparel, covered seating for main viewing area, sale items.

Building 3: Anderson Building: Antique machinery and storage building.

Building 4: Repair Shop: Used for restoration and repair of antique farm equipment.

Building 5: <u>Craft Fair:</u> Vendors, train depot, antique tools, bank vault door, Dr. Pecks buggy, barb wire, sad irons. **Building 6:** Building: Antique tractors, implements, and storage.

Building 7: <u>Thompson Building:</u> Car and truck museum, antique signs and license plates.

Building 8: Eggers Building: Historical crafts, pioneer rooms, vintage clothing, beauty shop, BCRHS Memorabilia
 Building 9: Blacksmith Shop: Working blacksmith demonstrating metal fabrication, bending and tempering steel.
 Building 10: Creamery: Antique milking machine, cream separator and dairy related items.

Building 11: Bacon Building: Steam engine shop, steam engines, Prony brake, baker fan, dynamometer.
Building 12A: Quilt Shop: Beautiful hand sewn quilts by locals, a display featuring Dee Dorsch's quilts.
Building 12B: Print Shop; Linotype Press, demonstration on how printing was done, print your own post cards.
Building 14: Dorsch-Sawyer Building: Tractor museum, rare and unusual antique tractors and implements.
Building 15: Brubaker-Fikan Building: Threshing machine, antique tractors and implements and storage area.
Building 16: Wilkens Building: Trucks, pickups, fire trucks, antique tractors, crawlers, signs, & 100+ pedal toys.
Building 17: Clark Building: Tractor pulling exhibit, 400 toy tractors, miniature farm, popcorn wagon & water wagon.
Building #18: Wright Building: Antique tractors, farm equipment, collectables, player piano demonstrations
Sod House: Built in 1985, see how the early homesteaders provided shelter for their families.
School House: Highland school house, free activities for kids take place everyday during the show.
Country Church: Neville Methodist Episcopal Church, provides an excellent example of a rural church.
Cook Shack: Example of how the ladies fed the large groups of men required for threshing.
